Choral Scholarship 2009

St Stephen's Uniting Church is offering three choral scholarships for 2009. These scholarships are open to students in years 10, 11 and 12, and undergraduate and graduate students in 2009. Applicants must be under the age of 35 as of 31st Dec 2009.

The scholarships have a value of Aus\$1,000, paid in two halves during the year.

The successful applicants will undertake to sing in the choir at St Stephen's Uniting Church during Sunday morning services and choir practices throughout the academic year. They will also take part in other Presbytery, Synod and community services, and other events as needed under the direction of the Director of Music and the Minister.

We are currently in search specifically for tenors and basses.

Interested applicants should reply in writing to the Director of Music, St Stephen's Uniting Church. No late applications can be accepted. Applications must include CV, academic record and at least one letter of recommendation. The Scholarship Committee will review the submitted material, and may invite applicants to an audition and interview. Auditions will take place in mid January 2009.

All invited applicants will undertake a short audition including the following:

- 2 contrasting pieces of their own choice
- Sight-reading a hymn at sight – in unison and tenor/bass parts

The successful applicants will be informed by February 2009.

Leave of absence from Church duties must be requested in writing at least 1 week in advance to the Director of Music, otherwise scholarship may be jeopardised.

Auditions for 2009 scholarships will be overseen by the Director of Music, Mr Adrian Chong, the Minister, Rev Dr Matthew Jack, and Chairperson of Church Council, Ms Rosalie Ramsay.
